



### Swavesey Festival 100 Club Rules

1. The 'Swavesey Festival 100 Club' shall commence on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2009.
  2. Membership of the 'Swavesey Festival 100 Club' shall be £36 per year per share, payable in advance by cheque (made payable to 'Swavesey Festival Limited') or by standing order at £3 per month. All standing order forms shall to be completed and returned by 14<sup>th</sup> of any month to be included in that month's prize draw.
  3. Membership of the 'Swavesey Festival 100 Club' is open to any one over the age of 16 including members, family and friends of the Swavesey Festival Steering Group'.
  4. Members may purchase multiple shares.
  5. The 'Swavesey Festival 100 Club' shall not be limited to 100 members.
  6. Each member is allocated a permanent number in the monthly draw. This number shall remain that member's number while they remain a paid up member. This number will be allocated by the administrator.
  7. There will be one prize draw each month, on the last Friday of the month. This will take place at 10pm at the White Horse Inn, Market Street, Swavesey and all are invited to witness the draw. At least one member of the Swavesey Festival Steering Group shall be present.
  8. Approximately 33% of the monthly payments make up the 'Prize Fund', while the remainder goes into Swavesey Festival funds. If there are 100 members the monthly prize will be £100 and pro-rata. On this basis the end of December prize will be £200
  9. In the event the membership falls below a critical level the 'Swavesey Festival Steering Group' may close the club. Any monies paid by members for draws which have not taken place will be repaid.
  10. In any matter requiring adjudication, the decision of the 'Swavesey Festival Steering Group' shall be final. The 'Swavesey Festival Steering Group' shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their discretion, and will provide reasonable notice to the members where necessary.
  11. The winners will be advised by telephone or email (as applicable) as soon as practicable after the draw has taken place.
  12. All prize money paid out will be by cheque
  13. Gift Aid will be claimed on all monies raised after prizes and expenses have been deducted if the Gift Aid box is ticked on the original application form.
  14. The 'Swavesey Festival 100 Club' will be registered with South Cambs District Council, in accordance with the Gambling Act 2005
